American Sign Language – Signs of the Month

This is the sign for ‘Independence’ or ‘Independent.’ To sign ‘Day’ make a ‘D’ with your dominant hand and your dominant arm laying across your non-dominant arm. Lift the dominant arm from the elbow so your hand is upright.
