Pastor Peter's Perspective

"Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet," -John 13:14.

It was the summer of 2001 in Ladysmith, Wisconsin. I was on my first mission trip as a seventh grader with our youth group and I was assigned

to a painting crew. I had never painted a home before, let alone experience a workcamp & all that goes with it (i.e. sleeping on a classroom floor, lack of sleep & air-conditioning, etc...). My crew painted George & Hope's home and they were elderly residents who didn't have the means to paint their home. Did I mention we painted the exterior bright yellow? We had to wear sunglasses because it was so bright! I'll never forget George & Hope's faces at the end of the week as they tearfully hugged each of us on the crew. I remember Hope telling us that God must've sent us to them that week. That made a lasting impact on me as a seventh grader... as it showed me that the faith I was learning about in youth group could be put into action... and lives could be changed.

God's love can be expressed so beautifully and objectively on a mission trip. That's why I keep going to workcamps and I love watching our youth group grow in their faith and serve on these trips, too. FLY has been attending Group Work Camps since 1993 (perhaps you were with Daryl in Binghamton, NY that year?). This month FLY is heading to Erie, PA to serve our neighbors in need through various service projects, from roofing to building decks to painting homes (maybe bright yellow!). We go on these trips not to pat ourselves on the back, but to simply share the love of Jesus with encouraging words and acts of service.

Jesus calls us to serve others in John 13:14 (see verse above) – reflecting Christ to the world. This is our call. This is our life. We are all on mission trips every day... whether it's serving our family, our neighbors, our friends, our church family, etc... It's not so much about the "service projects" (although the challenge is important); it's more about God changing the lives of the people we serve... and our hearts. The "work" fades, but the impact of selfless service and new relationships lasts!

Let's keep washing the feet of others in the name of Jesus. It might involve picking up a paintbrush or a shovel or a needle & thread. It might involve a phone call to someone who is lonely or a prayer with a neighbor. It might involve meeting people you've never met or tutoring a struggling student this summer. Opportunities for service are all around us.

These opportunities open our eyes to our neighbors' needs. An act of service may also ignite a spark of service that lasts a lifetime. May this month's mission trip do both of these things in our teenagers' lives. Join me in praying that it does.

And all God's children said, Amen!


Adult Education
