Pastor Peter's Perspective

Dear Faith Family,

Thank you for being part of this congregation as we seek to "Connect, Grow, and Serve" alongside each other in the name of Jesus. This past year has been an exciting time for our congregation as we have welcomed many new Faith members, grew our weekly worship attendance, baptized 13 children and adults, built and dedicated our new Pavilion, began a new mid-week worship service throughout the summer, upgraded our Livestream capabilities, expanded our church staff, welcomed close to 200 children in our Vacation Bible School, and experienced so many other ways in which the Holy Spirit has been active in the life of our congregation! I truly believe we're just getting started.

This fall we focused on the theme of "Loved & Sent." As Christians, our identity is that we are loved by God and He has given us a purpose by sending us to make disciples of all nations (Matt. 28:18-20). This is our mission, given to us by Christ Himself. It is not optional, nor is it reserved for a select few. Every baptized believer, every member of our congregation, has been sent by God into the world to proclaim the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ.

But how do we live out this mission? It starts with **stewardship**.
