American Sign Language – Signs of the Month

We will have a new sign each month, this month we have TWO (2). Since we have graduation this month, we thought it would be a good sign to learn!

Fall–To sign fall or autumn, make your flat, dominant hand move in a circular fashion on the elbow of your nondominant arm as the palm faces the ground. Clench your non-dominant hand into a fist as your open, dominant hand mimics falling leaves off your non-dominant elbow (which reminds us of a tree branch).



Football – To sign Football, First open both hands and spread all fingers apart. Then bring your hands together by interlocking all fingers and disengage them afterward. Repeat this lock-unlock sequence a couple of times in front of your body
