### American Sign Language Signs of the Month

Thanksgiving—To sign Thanksgiving do a modified compound sign with both hands for thank you and give. Use both open, flat hands, palms facing up, and make an outward-moving gesture from the mouth area (thank you) to a short distance from the body, then mimic that gesture a further distance away with both hands simultaneously (a modified sign for *give*).



**Turkey**- To sign turkey take your dominant hand to the bottom of your chin, wiggle the index finger and thumb pointing down.
