Our beautiful and brilliant new Christmas Wreath went through a major update last year. make much safer for raising and lowering of the 120 pound wreath. The wreath is assembled on the floor, and then carried by 4 men over stair rails, two sets of steps, partially over communion rail, cleared-off altar, and behind the cross while lifting it 30' up (via pulleys) to man at top of a 34' ladder.


