American Sign Language – Signs of the Month

Rainbow-To sign "Rainbow" (ASL), start with your hands open and thumbs near your palms, fingertips pointing down. Position your hands on opposite sides and move them in an arc upward, following the motion with your eyes.



Green- To sign "Green" Use the dominant hand in a "G" handshape, with the index finger and thumb extended and slightly apart. Place the dominant hand in front of your face, palm facing inward. Shake your dominant hand back and forth.
