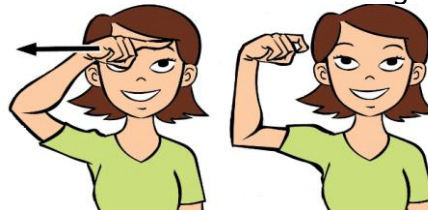

Flag - Your non-dominant hand is flat facing down to signify the ground. Your dominant hand waves back and forth like a flag blowing in the wind while your forearm signifies the flagpole.
