Special Voters Meeting Announcement

The Faith Leadership Board is inviting all Faith members to join us for a **Special Voters Meeting today at 12:30pm**. The purpose of this meeting is to present and vote on whether or not Faith begins phase one of the **Mission Driven Development (MDD) proposal** brought forward by the Faith Leadership Board.

What is MDD?

MDD is a multi-phased process that helps congregations and leaders identify what can, can't, and must be done to meet ministry and community needs while sharing the Gospel of Jesus. If approved, Faith would partner with the Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF). An LCEF consultant would guide Faith in creating a comprehensive vision and strategic plan for ministry, campus, and financial resources.

You may join the Special Voters Meeting via Zoom (the link has been shared via congregation-wide email). However, **all voting must be done in-person**. The full proposal is available in the Concourse. A free-will offering lunch will be provided at noon prior to the meeting. Staffed nursery care will be available in the church nursery.

2025 Update for Qualified Charitable Distributions

As many of you know, IRA owners age 70 1/2 and older can make tax-free charitable donations during the year through qualified charitable distributions (QCDs). The distribution remains tax-free if sent directly to a qualified charity by the IRA trustee. Starting in 2024, the QCD limit is subject to an annual adjustment, based on inflation. For that reason, the annual QCD limit has risen from the \$105,000 for 2024 to \$108,000 in 2025.
