American Sign Language Sign of the Month

Thanksgiving - To sign

Thanksgiving, do a modified compound sign with both hands for thank you and give. Use both open, flat hands, palms facing up, and make an outward-moving gesture from the mouth area (thank you) to a short distance from the body, then mimic that gesture a further distance away with both hands simultaneously (a modified sign for give).



Food - Make the sign for food by taking your strong hand, with the tip of your thumb touching the tips of your fingers and tapping them on your mouth twice.

This universal sign for eating is the same sign that is used for eat, which is done with only one tap. This universal sign for eating is the same sign used for food. The only difference is that verbs are signed once, and nouns are signed twice.
