Pastor Peter's Perspective



"Come, follow me," Jesus said... At once they left their nets and followed him." -Matthew 4:19-20

We have a Director of Christian Education (DCE) Intern joining us this month! Ella Gilzean is moving here from Concordia University, Nebraska and will be serving alongside Faith for a year as an intern. This year-long internship is the final requirement for her to become a DCE in the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod (LCMS). Her primary responsibilities at Faith will be to assist with our children's and youth ministries. This includes helping with Sunday School, children's events, VBS, FLY, FCCNS chapels, children's messages, and other ministry

opportunities. She has been assigned tasks and goal-setting from Concordia Nebraska and our church leadership. As Ella's on-site supervisor, we'll be working closely together in team ministry over the coming year. I am beyond excited to serve with Ella and see how God works through her this year!

It is important to know that Ella is a student with us. She is at Faith Lutheran to learn many things regarding the DCE role, while growing in her leadership abilities and faith in Jesus Christ. As a former DCE Intern myself, I know that this will be an exciting, nerve-wracking, fun, difficult, and joyful time for Ella (and sometimes all those emotions at once)! And that's all okay. God has called Ella to follow Him from California to Nebraska, and now to New York to share the Gospel of Jesus with all ages. What an adventure Ella is on and we are blessed to be part of it!

My friends, we are also on a journey of learning what it means to follow Jesus and using your God-given gifts to serve your neighbors, while pointing them to Jesus. Ella is not alone in this department. We all have "left our nets" and are following Jesus together in this great adventure of life in Him. Following Jesus together becomes tangible in the ways we open our lives to one another.

Throughout 2026, I invite you to take Ella out for a meal, invite her to your home, send her encouraging notes, pray for her by name, and learn her story. These simple acts of hospitality and care are holy work. They are part of how we, as the Body of Christ, come alongside someone God has called to serve His Church. You are helping form a future church worker, not only by what you say, but by how you love.

At the same time, Ella's presence among us is not just about what she will give, but about what God will do through all of us together. Her questions, energy, creativity, and willingness to learn will certainly bless our children and youth – and they will also challenge us to see ministry with fresh eyes. God often uses interns to remind us why we do what we do in the first place: make disciples.

As Ella learns what it means to serve as a DCE, may we also be reminded that following Jesus is a daily calling into relationships, into service, into grace, and into growth. So let's walk together as fellow disciples, trusting that the same Lord who called the fishermen by the Sea of Galilee is still at work here at Faith – shaping servants and drawing all generations closer to Himself. Thanks be to God for His Son who loves His Church!

Introducing Planning Center & Church Center at Faith

We're excited to share that over the coming year our congregation will begin using **Planning Center** and **Church Center** - two connected tools that will help us serve, communicate, and care for one another more clearly and consistently. **Planning Center** is the behind-the-scenes system our church staff and ministry leaders will use to organize worship services, schedules, events, groups, communication, and record your contributions. It helps ensure that details don't fall through the cracks, volunteers are supported, and ministry happens in an orderly and thoughtful way - all so our focus can remain on ministering to God's people rather than paperwork.

Church Center is the simple, easy-to-use app (and website) that you'll interact with most. Through Church Center, you'll be able to see upcoming events, sign up to serve, join groups, register for events, give securely, and stay connected to what's happening in the life of our church - all in one place. Our hope is that these tools will make it easier for you to stay informed and involved, while helping our church care for one another well. We'll be introducing features gradually and offering guidance along the way, so no one feels rushed or left behind as we take this next step together.

Over the next month, you may receive an email about the **Giving module** which handles your contributions. This email from Faith is designed as a security measure within the program to ensure that it is your wish to have your contributions shared with your spouse.

Later this winter we will be rolling out our **Vacation Bible School registration** through Church Center. More information on how to register and use Church Center will be forthcoming.

Our church staff will be sharing more info about these new tools at our **Annual Voters Meeting** on Feb. 1, 2026.

For November

The ongoing operations of Faith rely entirely on the generosity of the congregation to provide the funding support for the ministries that are so important to us and the community in which we serve.



A year in Review: Our Livestream Ministry

Our livestream here at Faith has evolved and adapted since 2020. In September of 2024, we had to make a choice on what new streaming platform to use as our old platform, "LivestreamStudio", was purchased by another company and would no longer be active or usable as of December of 2024. After careful consideration and thorough research, we decided to use "ProPresenter" as our presentation platform and "Resi" as our streaming platform. These tools were designed by and made for church workers, and we found these products to be the best fit for our church.

Our first livestream with these new products aired on September 1st, 2024. We livestreamed a basic video feed without any song lyrics or words on the screen until February 2nd, 2025. Since then, we have reincorporated lyrics into the livestream and have removed the need for an additional volunteer to operate the in-house slides on the projector. We now control the slides for the livestream and the in-house slides through one computer thanks to the combination of ProPresenter and Resi.

Many features of these products have changed our livestream experience both for those watching online and for the staff and volunteers that operate the livestream system. One feature that we use is the "Analytics" tool provided by Resi. This feature gives us data on the number of devices that view our livestream. Since September 1st, 2024 our livestream has been viewed by 8,211 individual devices from across the globe, averaging 86 devices each Sunday. Although 89% of our online worshipers live in New York, our worship services have been viewed by people from 6 other countries, including Australia, Canada, Ireland, Mexico, South Africa, and the United Kingdom.

This information is essential to tracking the impact of our online ministry and is representative of the impact our online worship has on not just our community here in Rochester, but around the world as well. As the Director of Digital Arts, I would like to thank all the volunteers that have been a part of our livestream production and to thank our congregation for the continued support and patience as we connect, grow, and serve through our online ministry.

It's a month that rarely feels extraordinary—and maybe that's the gift. We often look for God in the dramatic: answered prayers that shake the soul, turning-point moments, mountaintop experiences. But let's remember that the bible reminds us that God is just as present in the small, unremarkable spaces of our lives.

Elijah expected God in the wind, the earthquake, and the fire—yet God came in a gentle whisper. Jesus spent thirty years in Nazareth before He began His public ministry. And so much of His ministry happened not in grand events but in everyday moments: conversations over meals, walks along dusty roads, encounters in crowded streets.

January invites us to rediscover Him in the ordinary. In the quiet routines—morning coffee or tea or Coke Zero, commuting, washing dishes, caring for your family—God is nearby. Each simple task becomes an opportunity to meet Him. A whispered prayer while folding laundry. Gratitude rising during a sunset we almost didn't notice. A sense of peace found in the steady rhythm of responsibility. Ordinary days also give us space to grow. Growth rarely happens in the spotlight; most transformations, whether spiritual, emotional or physical, take place in small, consistent steps. It's in the daily choosing of patience, the repeated act of forgiveness, the unnoticed moments of kindness that God slowly shapes our hearts to look more like His.

If January feels unremarkable this year, take heart, these are the days God often uses to tend the soil of our souls. Don't overlook the grace hidden in routine or the presence of God woven into your everyday life. Extraordinary faith is almost always born in ordinary times. May this month teach us to slow down, pay attention, and welcome God into every simple moment—and to trust that He is already there. May 2026 bring you closer to Him and those you hold dear.

HOW TO REDUCE TAXABLE INCOME WITH A QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION

Updated for 2025



In an effort to help you be a good steward of the gifts God has given you, we would like to share a strategy that could be a blessing to you, your family, and our Faith family.

The generous standard deduction available for the current tax year is welcomed by many as it will simplify filing and could even reduce your tax bill. Even if you take the standard deduction, however, there is a tax-savvy strategy that allows retirees to further reduce their tax liability by taking advantage of qualified charitable distributions (QCDs) from their individual retirement accounts. This charitable rollover provision allows IRA owners 70 ½ years or older to transfer up to **\$108,000** for 2025 **directly** from their IRA to one or more qualified charities, without that donation being counted as taxable income when it is withdrawn. That's up from \$105,000 in 2024. Married couples can each donate up to their individual annual limit.

For those age 73 or older, these qualified charitable distributions count as part of the person's required minimum distributions from the IRA account.

Please consult your tax adviser and IRA trustee to make sure that you meet the qualifications to take advantage of this provision and that the distribution is properly processed.

If you would like to make a qualified charitable distribution to Faith Lutheran Church, please instruct your IRA trustee or custodian to make a transfer from the IRA **directly** to Faith Lutheran Church as the payee on the check. You may also have the distribution transferred **directly** from your IRA account to Faith Lutheran Church's checking account by contacting Kay Gerlach in the church office at **485-0412 or finance@faithpenfield.org** for the necessary information. Your donation will be credited to support the unified budget of Faith Lutheran Church unless you designate otherwise via written communication to either Kay Gerlach, Director of Finance, or Kris Cronk, Church Secretary.

Please know that we sincerely appreciate any gift you make to support the ministry and mission of Faith Lutheran Church. We are so blessed that God provides so many ways for us to be a part of His work here on earth! May your gifts serve as a reminder that God provides all that you have and has given to us His greatest gift of all – His Son, Jesus who gave His very life for you!
